BILL SUMMARY:

Senate Bill 560 amends General Statutes Chapters 95-25.5(a) and 108A-14(b), to make technical corrections regarding the issuance of certificates of employment to youths under 18 years of age. The bill would allow county directors of social services to delegate the authority to issue these certificates of employment to their designee, subject to the review by the Department of Labor. The bill further provides that county directors of social services may make this delegation of authority in writing.
