A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE TRANSPORTATION AND RESALE OF THE  
EDIBLE PARTS OF BEAR AND DEER TAKEN IN ANOTHER STATE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 113-291.3(b) is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:

"(8) The sale of the edible parts of bear and deer lawfully taken in another state may be transported into this State and resold as a meat product for human consumption when the edible parts have passed inspection in the other state by that state's inspection agency or the United States Department of Agriculture."

Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
