4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	Section 1. G.S. 113-291.3(b) is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:
6	"(8) The sale of the edible parts of bear and deer lawfully taken in another
7	state may be transported into this State and resold as a meat product for
8	human consumption when the edible parts have passed inspection in the
9	other state by that state's inspection agency or the United States
10	Department of Agriculture."
11	Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
