1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR ADDITIONAL POLICE OFFICERS IN THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES AND TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE JUVENILE EVALUATION CENTER IN BUNCOMBE COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Human Resources, Division of Youth Services, the sum of ninety-seven thousand four dollars (\$97,004) in recurring funds and the sum of three thousand nine hundred sixty dollars (\$3,960) in nonrecurring funds to fund three additional Police Officer I positions and one additional Police Officer II position in the Department.

Section 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Human Resources the sum of two million forty-one thousand five hundred nine dollars (\$2,041,509) for the 1997-98 fiscal year to construct a vocational classroom and auditorium at the Juvenile Evaluation Center located in Buncombe County.

Section 3. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Human Resources the sum of three hundred two thousand one hundred forty-five dollars (\$302,145) for the 1997-98 fiscal year and the sum of three hundred two thousand one hundred forty-five dollars (\$302,145) for the 1998-99 fiscal year for increased operating expenses and staffing needs at the Juvenile Evaluation Center in Buncombe County.

1 Section 4. This act becomes effective July 1, 1997.
