A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE CITY OF MAXTON FOR THE REHABILITATION OF THE RECREATION CENTER AND GYM BUILT IN THE EARLY 1940'S BY THE DAVIS BROTHERS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the City of Maxton in Robeson County the sum of one hundred twenty-eight thousand dollars (\$128,000) for the 1998-99 fiscal year to assist in the costs of rehabilitating the recreation center and gym built by the Davis Brothers in the early 1940's. This recreation center has a rich history, and once restored, can continue to have a positive impact on the youth of Maxton and the surrounding area.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1998.
