**A BILL TO BE ENTITLED**

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS FOR SENIOR CENTERS.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Aging, the sum of five million dollars (\$5,000,000) for the 1998-99 fiscal year for capital projects and renovations for senior centers. The Division of Aging shall allocate funds through a competitive grant process. Grants shall be awarded on the basis of need and shall be matched dollar-for-dollar with local funds.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1998.
