- 2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS FOR3 SENIOR CENTERS.
- 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
- 5 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of 6 Health and Human Services, Division of Aging, the sum of five million dollars 7 (\$5,000,000) for the 1998-99 fiscal year for capital projects and renovations for senior 8 centers. The Division of Aging shall allocate funds through a competitive grant process. 9 Grants shall be awarded on the basis of need and shall be matched dollar-for-dollar with 10 local funds.
