A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR SENIOR CENTERS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Aging, the sum of two million dollars (\$2,000,000) for the 1998-99 fiscal year to be allocated by the Division to support existing senior centers and to assist in the development of new senior centers. Funds allocated to support existing senior centers shall be allocated equally among the centers throughout the State.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1998.
