A JOINT RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE 1997 GENERAL ASSEMBLY, REGULAR SESSION 1998, TO CONSIDER A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT REQUIRING THAT DEFENDANTS CHARGED WITH A VIOLENT CRIME AND FOUND NOT GUILTY BY REASON OF INSANITY BE COMMITTED TO A FORENSIC UNIT OPERATED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES.
