A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO ADJUST SCHOOL FUNDING FORMULAS TO REFLECT CHANGES
IN AVERAGE DAILY MEMBERSHIP AND TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO
REIMBURSE A HOST LOCAL SCHOOL ADMINISTRATIVE UNIT FOR LOCAL
FUNDS SPENT FOR THE EDUCATION OF A STUDENT WHO IS RESIDING IN
A GROUP OR THERAPEUTIC HOME.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The State Board of Education shall examine and modify as necessary current measures of projecting average daily membership. The State Board shall give special attention to the needs of local school administrative units that may experience abrupt changes in average daily membership due to the presence of large military bases, new and expanding industry, and sudden fluctuations in the employment rate.

Section 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to State Aid to Local School Administrative Units the sum of three million five hundred ninety-five thousand two hundred seventy-five dollars (\$3,595,275) for the 1998-99 fiscal year for a reserve for severely disabled children in group or therapeutic homes. These funds shall be used to reimburse the local school administrative unit in which the group or therapeutic home

1 is located for the special education of children whose parents reside outside of that local
2 school administrative unit.

3 Section 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1998.
