The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. The General Assembly requests the North Carolina Supreme Court to consider and adopt rules to expedite appeals from all cases in which the defendant is convicted of murder in the first degree and the judgment of the superior court includes a sentence of death. Section 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial Department the sum of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) to implement rules

adopted by the Supreme Court that expedite appeals from first degree murder cases that
