1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 2 AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE DISCHARGE OF A FIREARM NEAR AN ELEMENTARY OR SECONDARY SCHOOL IN VANCE COUNTY. 3 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. It is a Class 1 misdemeanor to discharge a firearm within 1,000 feet 5 of an elementary or secondary school except when used in the defense of person or 6 7 property or when used pursuant to the lawful direction of law enforcement officers. Section 2. This act applies only to Vance County. 8 9

Section 3. This act becomes effective December 1, 1997, and applies to offenses committed on or after that date.
