A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO REPAIR AND RESTORE SEVERAL
HISTORIC STRUCTURES AT THE BEAUFORT HISTORIC SITE.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Cultural Resources, Division of Archives and History, the sum of two hundred forty-two thousand eight hundred twenty-eight dollars (\$242,828) for the 1997-98 fiscal year to be used by the Beaufort Historical Association, Inc., a nonprofit corporation, to repair and restore several historic structures at the Beaufort Historic Site including the Carteret County Jail, the Joseph Bell House, the Josiah Bell House, and the Fuller House.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1997.
