**A BILL TO BE ENTITLED**

**AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH COMMISSION TO  
STUDY THE LAW PROHIBITING HUNTING ON SUNDAY.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The Legislative Research Commission may study G.S. 103-2, which prohibits hunting on Sunday, and may recommend whether that law should be amended, repealed, or left intact. The Legislative Research Commission may report its findings and any recommendations to the 1999 General Assembly, and may make an interim report to the 1998 Regular Session of the 1997 General Assembly.

Section 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the General Assembly the sum of five thousand dollars (\$5,000) for the 1997-98 fiscal year and the sum of five thousand dollars (\$5,000) for the 1998-99 fiscal year to implement the provisions of this act.

Section 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1997.
