APPLICATION.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Agriculture the sum of six hundred seventy-seven thousand two hundred forty-four dollars (\$677,244) for the 1997-98 fiscal year and the sum of six hundred seventeen thousand two hundred forty-four dollars (\$617,244) for the 1998-99 fiscal year to meet the increased demand for analyses of soils and plants resulting from new regulatory requirements to determine whether animal waste is being utilized by the plants after its application to the land as needed for the proper management of animal waste.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1997.
