March 6, 1997 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO CREATE THE CRIMINAL OFFENSE OF ASSAULT WITH BODILY FLUIDS OR WASTES. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. Article 8 of Chapter 14 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read: "§ 14-34.8. Assault with bodily fluids or wastes. Unless a person's conduct is covered under some other provision of law providing greater punishment, a person who commits an assault with bodily fluids or bodily wastes is guilty of a Class I felony." Section 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 1997, and applies to offenses committed on or after that date.
