A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR LOW-WEALTH SCHOOL SYSTEMS'  
SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to State Aid to Local School Administrative Units the sum of fifty-three million six hundred forty-three thousand three hundred forty-three dollars (\$53,643,343) for the 1997-98 fiscal year and the sum of fifty-three million six hundred forty-three thousand three hundred forty-three dollars (\$53,643,343) for the 1998-99 fiscal year for low-wealth school systems' supplemental funding.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1997.
