A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR SCHOOL NURSES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. (a) There is appropriated from the General Fund to State Aid to Local School Administrative Units the sum of seven million eight hundred sixty-eight thousand eight hundred dollars (\$7,868,800) for the 1997-98 fiscal year and the sum of seven million eight hundred sixty-eight thousand eight hundred dollars (\$7,868,800) for the 1998-99 fiscal year for school nurses. The State Board of Education shall allocate these funds on the basis of one position for each 3,000 students in a local school administrative unit, with a minimum of one position per county. The State Board of Education shall make these funds available to a local school administrative unit only after the unit has developed a plan for the use of the funds in collaboration with the local health department and local health care providers.

- (b) Local school administrative units may use these funds to contract with local health departments or other public or private providers for school nursing services.
- (c) The State Board of Education shall not grant a waiver for the use of these funds pursuant to G.S. 115C-105.26(a).

1 Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1997.
