AN ACT TO REPEAL OBSOLETE SECTIONS OF CHAPTER 106 OF THE NORTH
CAROLINA GENERAL STATUTES.

- Section 3. G.S. 106-12 is repealed.
- Section 4. G.S. 106-13 is repealed.
- Section 5. G.S. 106-15, 106-16, 106-17, and 106-18 are repealed.
- Section 6. G.S. 106-19 is repealed.
- Section 7. G.S. 106-21 is repealed.
- Section 8. Article 15 of Chapter 106 of the General Statutes is repealed.
- Section 9. G.S. 106-197 is repealed.
- Section 10. G.S. 106-429.1 through G.S. 106-434 are repealed.
- Section 11. G.S. 106-436 through G.S. 106-451.1 are repealed.
- Section 12. This act is effective when it becomes law.
