The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. The Public Health Study Commission shall do the following: Determine the number of children in this State who do not have access (1) to health care because they are not covered by health insurance; Recommend strategies for providing adequate health care to these (2)

covered by health insurance.

The Commission may report its findings and recommendations, including any recommended legislation, to the 1997 General Assembly, Regular Session 1998, and shall make its final report on this study to the 1999 General Assembly, upon its convening.
