The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of two million dollars (\$2,000,000) for the 1997-98 fiscal year for the construction of a facility to serve as the Center for Craft, Creativity, and Design on the Kellogg property at the University of North Carolina at Asheville. Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1997.
