The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. G.S. 108A-25.1(a) reads as rewritten: The Department shall establish and maintain a uniform system in the "(a) Department and in all counties of identifying all Work First, food stamp, and medical

"(a) The Department shall establish and maintain a uniform system in the Department and in all counties of identifying all Work First, food stamp, and medical assistance program recipients. recipients except for recipients who are institutionalized adults. This system shall provide security and portability throughout the State and between the departments within the State involved in means-tested public assistance programs and shall have the capability of identifying recipients of assistance from all means-tested programs administered or funded through the Department."

Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
