May 27, 1998 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO IMPLEMENT THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE LEGISLATIVE STUDY COMMISSION ON PUBLIC SCHOOLS TO ENCOURAGE LOCAL BOARDS OF EDUCATION TO PROVIDE YEAR-ROUND SCHOOLS. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. G.S. 115C-47(11) reads as rewritten: "(11) To Determine the School Calendar. – Local boards of education shall determine the school calendar under G.S. 115C-84.2. Local boards of education are encouraged to provide at least one year-round school in each local school administrative unit for each grade span according to how the school system is organized under G.S. 115C-74. Local boards of education shall report to the State Board of Education the establishment of any year-round school under this subdivision." Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1998.
