2	AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND
3	HUMAN SERVICES FOR MENTAL HEALTH, DEVELOPMENTAL
4	DISABILITIES, AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE SERVICES AND FOR CAPITAL
5	IMPROVEMENTS AND OTHER ONE-TIME REQUESTS.
6	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
7	Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of
8	Health and Human Services, Division of Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities, and
9	Substance Abuse Services, the sum of one hundred million dollars (\$100,000,000) for the
10	1998-99 fiscal year to be allocated as follows:
11	(1) \$20,987,788 for Mental Health;
12	(2) \$37,820,000 for Developmental Disabilities; and
13	(3) \$23,813,918 for Substance Abuse Services.
14	The remainder of the funds appropriated to the Department under this section shall be
15	used for capital improvements and other one-time requests.
16	Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1998.
