The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the State Board of Education the sum of two million dollars (\$2,000,000) for the 1998-99 fiscal year for the State Board to establish and implement a program that provides grants or loans to charter schools for whom charters are approved. The State Board shall determine the amount of each grant or loan; however, no charter school shall receive more than fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000). Each grant or loan shall be used during the first year after the charter has been approved. The grant or loan shall be used for one-time costs or expenses related to starting the school.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1998.
