A SENATE RESOLUTION HONORING THE ONE HUNDREDTH ANNIVERSARY 1 2 OF NORTH CAROLINA MUTUAL LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY, ONE OF 3 NORTH CAROLINA'S GREATEST INSTITUTIONS. Whereas, North Carolina Mutual and Provident Association was founded on 4 5 October 20, 1898, by a group of seven prominent African-Americans: John Merrick, Dr. Aaron McDuffie Moore, Dr. James E. Shepard, William G. Pearson, Edward A. Johnson, 6 7 D.T. Watson, and N.C. Bruce; and 8 Whereas, North Carolina Mutual and Provident Association was chartered by 9 the General Assembly on February 28, 1899, largely due to the efforts of Senator Thomas 10 Oscar Fuller, North Carolina's only African-American senator at that time and the sponsor of the legislation; and 11 12 Whereas, North Carolina Mutual and Provident Association began selling 13 burial insurance in April of 1899; and Whereas, by 1903, North Carolina Mutual and Provident Association hired its 14 first full-time insurance agents and produced its first publication. The North Carolina 15 16 Mutual, a newspaper that kept the community informed about the Association; and

1	Whereas, in 1919, North Carolina Mutual and Provident Association's charter
2	was amended, changing its name to North Carolina Mutual Life Insurance Company; and
3	Whereas, North Carolina Mutual Life Insurance Company is the oldest and
4	largest African-American life insurance company in the United States and the oldest life
5	insurance company in North Carolina; and
6	Whereas, North Carolina Mutual Life Insurance Company is licensed to
7	operate in 21 states and the District of Columbia and has district and branch offices in 10
8	states and the District of Columbia; and
9	Whereas, with more than nine billion dollars of insurance in force, North
10	Carolina Mutual Life Insurance Company is ranked approximately 175 of the
11	approximately 1,800 life insurance companies in the United States; and
12	Whereas, in 1986, NCM Capital Management Group, Inc., was formed to
13	expand the company's presence in the financial arena to diversify its business and
14	investment combinations; and
15	Whereas, during its 100 years of business, North Carolina Mutual Life
16	Insurance Company has been led by only eight presidents: John Merrick, Dr. Aaron
17	McDuffie Moore, Charles C. Spaulding, William Kennedy Jr., Asa T. Spaulding, Joseph
18	W. Goodloe, William Kennedy III, and Bert Collins; and
19	Whereas, since its beginning, North Carolina Mutual Life Insurance Company
20	has used its resources to support civic and social organizations throughout Durham and
21	North Carolina; and
22	Whereas, it is only fitting that North Carolina Mutual Life Insurance Company
23	be commended for its 100 years of continuous operation; Now, therefore,
24	Be it resolved by the Senate:
25	Section 1. The Senate congratulates North Carolina Mutual Insurance
26	Company on its one hundred year anniversary and commends the company for its
27	continued commitment to the City of Durham.
28	Section 2. The Principal Clerk shall transmit a certified copy of this resolution
29	to the President of North Carolina Mutual Insurance Company.
30	Section 3. This resolution is effective upon adoption.
