A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR SALMONELLA TESTING OF MEAT
FOOD PRODUCTS.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Agriculture the sum of twenty-one thousand two hundred fifty dollars (\$21,250) for the 1997-98 fiscal year and the sum of twenty-one thousand two hundred fifty dollars (\$21,250) for the 1998-99 fiscal year for salmonella testing of meat food products as required by federal regulations. These funds will be matched by the United States Department of Agriculture, pursuant to the Federal Meat Inspection Act.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1997.
