A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO MAKE SPEEDING IN EXCESS OF THE POSTED SPEED ON SCHOOL  
GROUNDS AN INFRACTION.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 20-141 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

"(e1) Local authorities, in their respective jurisdictions, upon the request of, and with the approval of, a local school administrative unit for public schools or the governing body of a private school, may authorize by ordinance lower speeds than those set out in subsection (b) of this section, not to exceed 15 miles per hour, on all school property. Speed limits set pursuant to this subsection shall be effective when appropriate signs giving notice of the speed limits are erected upon the affected property."

Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
