SENATE BILL 735

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT ALLOWING THE BOARDS OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS IN ALL COUNTIES TO ASSUME DIRECT CONTROL OF COUNTY BOARDS, COMMISSIONS, AND AGENCIES AND ALLOWING ALL COUNTIES HAVING COUNTY MANAGERS TO MODIFY OR CONSOLIDATE THE LOCAL ADMINISTRATION AND DELIVERY OF HUMAN SERVICES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 153A-77(f) is repealed.

Section 2. Any county which consolidates human services pursuant to G.S. 153A-77(b) shall report on the implementation of consolidated human services as required by Section 16 of Chapter 690 of the 1995 Session Laws.

Section 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1997. Section 2 of this act expires January 1, 2001.
