Whereas, currently, Blue Ridge Community College is constructing an Allied Health and Human Services Building funded by the 1993 statewide bond referendum; and

Whereas, due to construction costs, funds are not available to complete and furnish the Allied Health and Human Services Auditorium; and

Whereas, the 500-seat teaching auditorium is designed to serve as a facility for a number of activities including: the college's Associate in Fine Arts program; the Blue Ridge Community College concert series; the Western North Carolina Rescue College; the Blue Ridge Center for Lifelong Learning lecture series; business and industry training; and training for professional organizations, government agencies, and civic groups; Now, therefore,

- 5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
  - Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Community Colleges the sum of two million dollars (\$2,000,000) for the 1997-98 fiscal year to complete and furnish the 500-seat teaching auditorium located in the Allied Health and Human Services Building on the campus of Blue Ridge Community College.
    - Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1997.
