A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO EXEMPT PERSONS PERFORMING CERTAIN ALTERATIONS,  
REMODELING, AND RENOVATIONS OF EXISTING BUILDINGS OR  
STRUCTURES FROM THE ARCHITECTURAL LICENSURE REQUIREMENTS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 83A-13(c)(5) reads as rewritten:

"(5) Alteration, ~~remodeling~~ remodeling, or renovation of an existing building ~~which~~ that is exempt under this section, or alteration, remodeling, or renovation of an existing building or building site ~~which~~ that does not alter or affect the ~~structural system of the building;~~ load on the building's mechanical, electrical, or life safety systems, change the live or dead load on the building's structural system, or change the building's access or exit pattern."

Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
