4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	Section 1. Article 8 of Chapter 143 of the General Statutes is amended by
6	adding a new section to read:
7	"§ 143-134.2. No damage for delay clause.
8	No contractual language forbidding or limiting compensable damages for delays
9	caused by the owner may be enforced in any construction contract let by any board or

governing body of the State, or of any institution of State government, or of any county,
city, town, or other political subdivision thereof."

12 Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to 13 construction contracts entered into after that date.
