April 21, 1997 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO ALLOW THE ISSUANCE OF CERTAIN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL PERMITS IN INTERSTATE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT ZONES. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. G.S. 18B-1006 is amended by adding a new subsection to read: Interstate Interchange Economic Development Zones. – The Commission may issue permits listed in G.S. 18B-1001(10), without approval at an election, to qualified establishments defined in G.S. 18B-1000(4), (6), and (8) located within one and one-half miles of an interstate highway interchange located in a county that: Has approved the sale of malt beverages, unfortified wine, and fortified (1) wine, but not mixed beverages; Operates ABC stores; (2) Borders on another state; and (3) Lies north of the Roanoke River." **(4)** Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
