The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Commerce the sum of one million twenty-five thousand dollars 1997-98 fiscal year and the sum of one million twenty-five thousand for the 1998-99 fiscal year to be allocated as follows:	(\$1,025,000) for the
(1) \$500,000 to the North Carolina Community Dev Inc., to provide operating and project activity community development corporations that have a and organizational capacity;	y grants to mature
(2) \$20,000 to the North Carolina Institute for Development, Inc., to foster minority economic development through policy analysis, information and resource expansion and support of community-line.	velopment within the technical assistance,

initiatives;

\$200,000 to the North Carolina Minority Support Center (formerly 1 (3) 2 known as the Minority Credit Union Support Center) for technical 3 assistance to community-based minority credit unions; 4 \$100,000 to the North Carolina Association of the Community **(4)** Development Committees to provide training, technical assistance, 5 6 resource development, project assistance, and support for local 7 community development corporations statewide; 8 (5) \$100,000 to the Land Loss Prevention Project, Inc., to provide free legal 9 representation to low-income, financially distressed small farmers. The 10 Land Loss Prevention Project, Inc., shall not use these funds to represent farmers who have income and assets that would make them 11 12 financially ineligible for legal services pursuant to Title 45, Part 1611 of 13 the Code of Federal Regulations; and 14 (6) \$105,000 to The North Carolina Coalition of Farm and Rural Families 15 to promote self-help economic development among rural and farm families in agribusiness. 16 17 There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Sainte's 18 Assisted Independent Living, Inc., a nonprofit corporation, the sum of eighty thousand dollars (\$80,000) for the 1997-98 fiscal year to support the Floyd B. McKissick, Sr. 19 20 Assisted Living Center, a residential center for the elderly and disabled in Warren 21 County.

Section 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1997.
