**PROGRAM(S) AFFECTED:** Six private, non-profit corporations in North Carolina, as follows:  
Metrolina Food Bank, Inc., the Food Bank, Inc., The Food Bank of  
Northwest North Carolina, Inc., the MANNA Food Bank, Inc., the Albermarle Food Bank/Food Pantry,  
Inc., the Cumberland Community Action Program, Inc., for the Cape Fear Community Food Bank.

**EFFECTIVE DATE:** July 1, 1997

**BILL SUMMARY:** Appropriates funds in equal amounts to each nonprofit entity cited above,  
as follows:

For the purchase of food items: \$337,000

For operating costs associated with transportation, handling,  
and distribution: \$37,500

**ASSUMPTIONS AND METHODOLOGY:** Multiply \$337,000 by 6 (\$2,022,000); then,  
multiply \$37,500 by 6 (\$225,000). Total \$ 2,247,000

**TECHNICAL CONSIDERATIONS:** Consider amending bill to add an additional, \$500 each to either food purchases or operating costs for each of the nonprofit corporation, or consider reducing the total appropriation by \$3,000.
