A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO ALLOW THE STOCKING OF ANIMALS BY CERTAIN PERSONS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Section 2 of Chapter 615 of the 1983 Session Laws reads as rewritten:

"Section 2. This act shall become effective ~~October 1, 1983~~ October 1, 1983, but shall not apply to persons who were engaged in the stocking of wild animals or wild birds covered by this act on or before that date, or to persons taking wild animals or wild birds stocked by those persons."

Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
