April 15, 1999 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT ESTABLISHING LONGEVITY PAYMENTS FOR MEMBERS OF THE 2 3 GENERAL ASSEMBLY. 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. G.S. 120-3 is amended by adding a new subsection to read: 5 6 "(d) Every member of the General Assembly shall receive as longevity pay an annual amount equal to four and eight-tenths percent (4.8%) of the annual salary set forth 7 in this section payable monthly after five years of service, nine and six-tenths percent 8 (9.6%) after 10 years of service, fourteen and four-tenths percent (14.4%) after 15 years 9 of service, and nineteen and two-tenths percent (19.2%) after 20 years of service. 10 'Service' means service as a member of the General Assembly." 11 Section 2. This act becomes effective upon the convening of the 2001 General 12 13 Assembly.
