A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF AN ADDITIONAL ASSISTANT DISTRICT ATTORNEY POSITION IN THE THIRTEENTH PROSECUTORIAL DISTRICT.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 7A-60(a1) reads as rewritten:

"(a1) The counties of the State are organized into prosecutorial districts, and each district has the counties and the number of full-time assistant district attorneys set forth in the following table:

4 the Judicial Department the sum of seventy-seven thousand seven hundred eighty-four
5 dollars (\$77,784) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year and the sum of seventy-one thousand six
6 hundred fifty-two dollars (\$71,652) for the 2000-2001 fiscal year to establish the assistant
7 district attorney position provided for in this act.
8 Section 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
