Section 1. The Department of Environment and Natural Resources shall review its current procedures concerning permits issued for open burning in or near woodlands under the protection of the Department of Environment and Natural Resources under Article 4C of Chapter 113 of the General Statutes when the burning is to occur on five or more acres of land and shall determine whether more controls are needed in order to protect the public or the environment, or both. The Department shall report its findings and recommendations, including legislative proposals, if any, to the Environmental Review Commission no later than May 15, 2000.

Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
