April 15, 1999 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT THE MONTHLY WIRELESS ENHANCED 911 SERVICE CHARGE MAY NOT BE LEVIED AGAINST A CONNECTION BELONGING TO A PERSON IN A COUNTY THAT DOES NOT HAVE AT LEAST NINETY-FIVE PERCENT SERVICE. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. G.S. 62B-3 is amended by adding a new subsection to read: "(c1) No CMRS provider may levy the charge authorized in this section against a CMRS connection belonging to a person who resides, is employed, or is a student in a county in which less than ninety-five percent (95%) of the area of the county receives reliable commercial mobile radio service." Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
