A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT THE MONTHLY WIRELESS ENHANCED 911  
2 SERVICE CHARGE MAY NOT BE LEVIED AGAINST A CONNECTION  
3 BELONGING TO A PERSON IN A COUNTY THAT DOES NOT HAVE AT  
4 LEAST NINETY-FIVE PERCENT SERVICE.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 Section 1. G.S. 62B-3 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

8 "(c1) No CMRS provider may levy the charge authorized in this section against a  
9 CMRS connection belonging to a person who resides, is employed, or is a student in a  
10 county in which less than ninety-five percent (95%) of the area of the county receives  
11 reliable commercial mobile radio service."

12 Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
