A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT TO REQUIRE A ONE-YEAR SUSPENSION FOR ANY STUDENT WHO
3 BRINGS OR POSSESSES A FIREARM OR EXPLOSIVE ON SCHOOL
4 PROPERTY OR AT A SCHOOL-SPONSORED OR SCHOOL-RELATED
5 ACTIVITY ON OR OFF SCHOOL PROPERTY.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 Section 1. G.S. 115C-391(d1) reads as rewritten:

8 "(d1) A local board of education or superintendent shall suspend for 365 days any
9 student ~~who brings~~ who:

10 (1) Brings onto school property or to a school-related activity on or off
11 school property, or

12 (2) Possesses on school property or at a school-related activity on or off
13 school property,

14 a weapon, as defined in G.S. 14-269.2(b) and ~~G.S. 14-269.2(g), onto school property.~~ G.S.
15 14-269.2(g). The local board of education upon recommendation by the superintendent
16 may modify this suspension requirement on a case-by-case basis that includes, but is not
17 limited to, the procedures established for the discipline of students with disabilities and
18 may also provide, or contract for the provision of, educational services to any student
19 suspended pursuant to this subsection in an alternative school setting or in another setting
20 that provides educational and other services."

1 Section 2. This act becomes effective August 1, 1999.
