5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	Section 1. The Legislative Research Commission may study issues relating to
7	the authority of State agencies to enter into guaranteed energy savings contracts. The
8	topics to be considered by the Legislative Research Commission shall include, but are not
9	limited to, whether State agencies should be authorized to enter into guaranteed energy
10	savings contracts and, if so, how this authority should be implemented. In conducting the
11	study authorized by this section, the Legislative Research Commission may consider the
12	findings, recommendations, and legislative proposals of the Report to the 1993 General
13	Assembly from the Legislative Research Commission Committee on Ways to Promote
14	the Conservation of Energy and the Use of Renewable Energy Sources in Residential,
15	Commercial, Industrial, and Public Facilities. The Legislative Research Commission
16	shall present its findings and recommendations, if any, to the 2000 Regular Session of the
17	1999 General Assembly.
18	Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
