A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR TWO VOCATIONAL REHABILITATION  
POSITIONS IN RANDOLPH COUNTY AND TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR  
VOCATIONAL REHABILITATION SERVICES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Vocational Rehabilitation Services, the sum of sixty-seven thousand nine hundred seventy-nine dollars (\$67,979) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year and the sum of sixty-one thousand nine hundred seventy-nine dollars (\$61,979) for the 2000-2001 fiscal year to establish and support an additional vocational rehabilitation counselor position and a rehabilitation casework assistant position, including equipment and support. Both positions shall be located in Randolph County.

Section 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Human Services the sum of seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year and the sum of seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) for the 2000-2001 fiscal year to pay for vocational rehabilitation services in Randolph County.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
