A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT
AND NATURAL RESOURCES, DIVISION OF PARKS AND RECREATION, FOR
ACQUISITION OF ADDITIONAL PARKLANDS AT LAKE JAMES STATE
PARK.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Environment and Natural Resources, Division of Parks and Recreation, the sum of five million dollars (\$5,000,000) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year to assist in the acquisition of additional parklands at Lake James State Park for outdoor recreation and conservation.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
