A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE GREENSBORO CHILDREN'S MUSEUM.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Greensboro Children's Museum, Inc., a nonprofit corporation, the sum of five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year and the sum of five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) for the 2000-2001 fiscal year to help support the museum, which provides interactive exhibits designed to inspire creativity, foster curiosity, and engage the minds of children of all ages. The museum will play a vital role in the City of Greensboro's downtown redevelopment area and emerging cultural district.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
