## **HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION 1365**

## April 29, 1999

A JOINT RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH COMMISSION TO STUDY CHAPTER 51 OF THE GENERAL STATUTES.

Be it resolved by the House of Representatives, the Senate concurring:

Section 1. The Legislative Research Commission shall study Chapter 51 of the General Statutes. The study shall address the following issues:

- (1) What should be the responsibilities of the register of deeds in determining whether applicants are eligible for a license.
- What should be the requirements for the issuance of licenses to persons under 18 years of age, including situations when the female applicant is pregnant or has borne a child.
- (3) The persons who are authorized to give consent to the marriage of underage applicants.
- (4) The persons who are authorized to solemnize marriages.
- (5) What should be the duration and geographical scope of a marriage license.
- (6) What should be the penalties for solemnizing a marriage without a license or with an invalid license.
- (7) Any other issue the Legislative Research Commission deems relevant.
- The Commission shall make a final report of its findings and recommendations, including any legislative proposals, regarding revisions to Chapter 51 of the General Statutes to the 2001 General Assembly. The Commission may make an interim report to the 1999

General Assembly, 2000 Regular Session.
