April 29, 1999 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH COMMISSION TO STUDY MAGISTRATES' SALARIES. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. The Legislative Research Commission may study (i) the need to adjust the salaries of magistrates according to the size and caseload of the districts in which they are employed and (ii) the possibility of including magistrates within the Consolidated Judicial Retirement System. Section 2. The Legislative Research Commission shall report its findings and any recommendations to the 2001 General Assembly and may make an interim report to the 2000 Regular Session of the 1999 General Assembly. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the General Section 3.

Assembly the sum of fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year to

reimburse travel and subsistence expenses for the study authorized by this act.

Section 4. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
