The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:  Section 1. G.S. 105-129.3A(a) reads as rewritten:	
"(a) Development Zone Defined. – A development zone is an area comprised	οf
one or more contiguous census tracts, census block groups, or both in the most rece	
federal decennial census that meets all of the following conditions:	
(1) It is located in whole or in part in a city with a population of more the 5,000 1,500 according to the most recent annual population estimat certified by the State Planning Officer.	
(2) It has a population of 1,000 or more according to the most recent annu	ıal
population estimates certified by the State Planning Officer.	
(3) More than twenty percent (20%) of its population is below the pover	ty
level according to the most recent federal decennial census."	
Section 2. This act becomes effective January 1, 2000.
