		It has a population of 1,000 or more according to the most recent annual
		population estimates certified by the State Planning Officer.
		More than twenty percent (20%) of its population is below the poverty
		level according to the most recent federal decennial census."
	Section	1 2. This act becomes effective January 1, 2000.
